NOTIFICATION

The Academic Council, in its 422nd meeting held on 26/11/2024, approved the following admission guidelines and protocols for implementing the Study in India (SII) Programme in IARI.

A. Number of seats

IARI plans to admit international students in compliance with the SII guidelines for this initiative. Since there is a constraint on housing and other logistics, the program shall be offered only to the doctoral program initially. The seats designated for this initiative shall be supernumerary, and as per the UGC guidelines and shall not include international students under exchange programmes or/and through a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between institutions or between the Government of India and other countries.

For the 2024-25 academic sessions, 15 seats shall be earmarked for doctoral programs across all disciplines, making up approximately 7.5% of the total 200 seats available annually. Admissions shall exclusively take place at the IARI campus in New Delhi, in the first phase.

B. Eligibility

Age: The minimum age requirement shall be 22 years for the doctoral degree programme.

Nationality: Applicants must be Foreign Nationals. Overseas residents who qualify for the status of Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) or Non-resident Indian (NRI) are also eligible to apply under this program.

Passport: Candidates must possess a valid passport with at least 6 months validity remaining from the date of program completion.

C. Academic qualifications

Doctoral Program: Applicants must have completed 12 years of formal education at the school level with a minimum of 60% of the total marks. A pass with a minimum of 60% marks/ cumulative grade points in a 4-year undergraduate program as evidenced by a certified Bachelor's Degree and a pass with a minimum of 60% of the total marks/ cumulative grade points in the 2-year Master's Program with research in the area of specialization as evidenced by the certified Degree certificate and dissertation certificate,

(or)

A pass with a minimum of 60% of the total marks/cumulative grade points in the 5-year integrated master's program with research in the area of specialization as evidenced by the certified Degree certificate and dissertation certificate.

Qualifying subjects in the Master's Programme shall be as per the general subject guidelines of IARI. Applicants are required to submit certified academic transcripts.

D. Additional qualifications

Publications: Peer- reviewed publications having JCR impact factor / awarded patents as evidenced by reprints, or certifications shall be considered during the selection process, but not a mandatory requirement. Publications with the candidate as the first author shall only be considered.

English Language Proficiency: Proficiency in the English language as certified by any one of the following tests is required: IELTS-Academic, ToEFL iBT, PTE Academic and CAE. Additional skill tests such as SAT and ACT are also acceptable. If any of the above certificates are not available, the student needs to take an IARI-English Proficiency Test (IEPT).

J. Overseas students medical Insurance (OSMI)

It shall be compulsory for the students to have medical insurance coverage that is valid within India, before getting admitted into this programme. Students need to purchase medical insurance for foreign students directly from the insurance providers. IARI does not provide any insurance purchase facility.

K. Residential facilities

IARI plans to accommodate the international students on campus, with its limited student housing facilities in the international boys' and girls' hostels. Hostel accommodation shall be optional to students and shall be provided on a single or twin-sharing basis. Given the plan to accommodate 15 international students annually under this programme, over the next four years, the institute anticipates hosting a minimum of 60 students simultaneously on campus. A studio apartment with essential amenities shall be provided. The living expenses shall be borne by the students.

L. Flexibility options

The authority to make flexibility on the above conditions, if deemed fit, shall be vested on the Director and Vice Chancellor, IARI.

The Academic Council, in its 422nd meeting held on 26/11/2024, has approved the following revised guidelines of IARI M.Sc./M.Tech. and Ph.D. Merit Medal:

CRITERIA FOR ASSESSMENT OF COMPARATIVE MERIT

The weightage given to the different aspects for consideration of the award of IARI Merit Medal is given below:

- A. For M.Sc./M.Tech. (50 + 30 + 20) = 100 Marks
 - (a) OGPA: 50 marks (OGPA 10 = 50 marks)
 - (b) Thesis presentation & discussion: 30 marks
 - (c) Research papers (Maximum 15 marks) [weightage increased from 10 marksgiven in the existing guidelines]
 - i) Consideration of the research papers (accepted/published) for the purpose of computing marks:
 - The research papers accepted or published in journals with NAAS rating or international impact factor (Thomson Reuters or Scopus) will **ONLY BE** considered
 - NAAS rating >6.00 (any number of papers)
 - NAAS rating 5.00 6.00 (only one paper will be considered in this category, 5.0 and 6.0 are included)
 - NAAS rating <5.00 (will not be considered)
 - ii) Computation of marks for research published/accepted:
 - Marks for a research paper = 1 x (NAAS rating or 6.0 +Impact Factor (IF) of the journal in which research paper published)

Note: The year of IARI Merit Medal Award will be used for the purpose of obtaining NAAS rating and IF of the journal

The Academic Council, in its 422nd meeting held on 26/11/2024, approved the Indemnity Bond as per details as follows:

A. Collaborative initiatives with FHEIs require significant investments of time, energy, and financial resources. The withdrawal of students during the selection process or while being enrolled in the program at the FHEI undermines the program's success and jeopardizes the mutual understanding and academic interests of both institutions. To prevent this, it is recognized that students participating in twinning, joint degree, and dual degree programs, which offer opportunities to study abroad, must be required to sign an indemnity bond.

Bond value: The base value of the bond shall be an amount equivalent to 50% of the total fellowship and contingency support received by the student from IARI until the time of exit, rounded to the nearest 100 rupees. This 50% is in recognition of the successful completion of coursework and the student's committed research at IARI, as duly endorsed by the Advisory Committee.

If a student is approved to continue receiving fellowship or scholarship support from IARI while at the FHEI, due to the lack of other financial support (aside from a fee waiver) from the FHEI, the total amount of the IARI fellowship received by the student during their time at the FHEI will be added to the base bond value as outlined in the preceding paragraph. No contingency shall be paid at FHEI.

Interest rate: The interest rate shall be simple interest of 6%

NOTIFICATION

The Academic Council, in its 422nd meeting held on 26/11/2024, approved the following relief procedure for students selected for Dual Degree programs:

- A. Under the NEP 2020, IARI is forging academic alliances with other foreign higher education institutions (FHEIs). IARI, the Home institution, currently operates a Dual degree PhD program with Western Sydney University (WSU), Australia, the Host institution. There are five stages (denoted as S1 to S5) of the student admissions process under this Programme. In S5, students are concurrently enrolled in both the home and host institutions and period of such enrollment is mandatorily set to a minimum of 12 months.
 - S1: Advertisement, preliminary evaluation and generation of student's proposals
 - S2: Proposal screening, support letter generation and applying for admission at host institution
 - S3: Individual candidature agreement
 - S4: Confirmation of enrollment; and
 - S5: Physical reporting at the foreign institution.

After completion of S4, the student shall be required to complete all the formalities to get relived from the Home institution (IARI), before travelling to and reporting at the host institution which falls under S5. An indemnity bond shall apply to a candidate before getting relieved from IARI, the format of which is placed as the next item on the agenda.

However, being a new program no clear procedure to relieve students on concurrent enrollment system is in place as of now in the Green Book of IARI. The proposed guidelines were approved to be applied to future Dual/joint degree programs of IARI in general.

These procedures shall be called "Relief procedures for students selected for Dual Degree programs"

Scope: These procedures shall apply only to those students, who are successful in securing admission in the Dual Degree Ph.D. program following all the admission protocols as approved by IARI and the foreign higher education institution (FHEI) in their Memorandum of Understanding/Agreement.

Eligibility: To become eligible to get relieved from IARI to join the host institution, the student shall complete the following requirements.

- (a) Minimum residency period at IARI, as per the extant UGC Regulations and as specified in the Dual degree MoA/ Individual Candidate Agreement
- (b) Updation of the Outline of Research Work including the works committed at the FHEI
- (c) Successful completion of course work as mandated under the PhD degree program at IARI
- (d) Successful completion of the qualifying exam at IARI
- (e) Successful completion of all the approved research works at IARI
- (f) Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) / Admission from FHEI
- (g) Mandatory clearance from all the relevant divisions/ departments/ offices of IARI
- (h) Visa from the host institution (FHEI) country
- (i) Signing of the indemnity bond in Rs 100 stamp paper

Procedure

- (a) The student shall submit a request for relieving as per the format given in Annexure 1 along with all the documents as mentioned in the checklist below through their advisory committee to Professor of the concerned Division. All the copies shall be self- attested.
- (b) The request shall be examined by the respective Board of Studies (BoS), which shall send its recommendations to the Graduate School through Head of the Division and Office of the International Affairs (OIA)
- (c) OIA, after verification, shall submit the documents to the Graduate School for relieving the student with the approval of Competent Authority.
- (d) After approval of the Competent Authority, the relieving order clearly mentioning references to the conditions in the MoA/ ICA shall be then issued to the Student from the Graduate School (Annexure 2).
