Dr Stefan Kusch

RWTH, Aachen, Germany

Stefan Kusch studied biology at Göttingen University (Germany) and earned his Ph.D. at RWTH Aachen University (Germany) in and earned his Ph.D. at RWTH Aachen University (Germany) in 2017. He then joined the INRAE in Toulouse (France), where he helped uncover the evolution of broad host range in a fungal plant pathogen. In 2019, he rejoined RWTH Aachen University to study powdery mildew fungi. His current research is funded by starting grants from the Excellent Research Space at RWTH, and the German Research Foundation. Stefan's work with powdery mildew fungi began in 2012, when he investigated effectors assuming an RNase-like fold in his Master's thesis. Since then, he has focused on the molecular cenetics and evolution of plant-nowder then, he has focused on the molecular genetics and evolution of plant-powdery then, he has focused on the molecular genetics and evolution of plant-powder mildew interactions. In addition to dissecting the genetics behind isolates of the cereal pathogen Blumeria graminis f.p. hordei overcoming mlo-based broad-spectrum powdery mildew resistance, he investigates how transposable elements affect the genomes of these fungi, their regulation, and their contribution to the innovation of novel coding and noncoding RNA molecules. In a broader sense, he is leading efforts towards comparative genome analysis of powdery mildew fungi and the evolution of the obligate biotrophic lifestyle in the libracion. in this lineage.

Dr Jérôme Enjalbert

Senior Researcher, INRA, France

Jerome's current research aims are understanding how the Jerome's current research aims are understanding how the management of intra-specific diversity in crops can contribute to a better performance of crops, and more specifically the effect of plant to plant interactions in wheat cultivar mixtures, through experimental approaches as well as development of models coupling ecophysiology and genetics (Wheatamix – WALTer). Dr. Achintya N. Bezbaruah, Associate Professor and Director, NAE Grand Challenges Scholars Program, North Dakota State University will be your faculty host.

It gives us great pleasure to send you the Fulbright- Nehru grant document (Award No. 2685 FNPDR/ 2021). If you accept the award, please sign, scan and return an electronic copy to USIEF.

As part of your grant, you will receive a maintenance allowance of \$2,850 per month for a period not exceeding 24 months; \$1,000 professional allowance; \$500 settling-in allowance; \$100 transit allowance and \$500 excess baggage allowance.

As part of your Fulbright grant benefits, you will also receive roundtrip transportation via economy class from your place of residence in Delhi to Fargo, ND in accordance with Fulbright guidelines. Your travel will be arranged in consultation with you and in accordance with USIEF regulations. You will fly on airlines covered under the Fly America Act or by Air India. If you are on an eight to twenty-four months grant, subject to availability of funds, a dependent allowance of \$200 and international travel may be provided for one accompanying eligible dependent provided the dependent is with you in the U.S. for at least 80% of the grant period.

If you are employed, the fellowship has been awarded to you on the assumption that you will be given leave by your employer for your research/teaching/professional development in the U.S. This should be confirmed officially to us as soon as possible. Since funds in this program are extremely limited, no extensions are possible.

IIE, the coordinating agency in the United States, has been designated by the FSB and the U.S. Department of State to arrange, verify and supervise the professional programs of foreign scholars visiting the United States to conduct advanced research under the Fulbright-Nehru program.

USIEF expects you to remain in touch with USIEF and IIE during the course of your grant. You are required to submit **two** reports on your U.S. experience and impressions—one to IIE at the end of your stay before leaving the U.S. and the second to USIEF after your return. Since all awards under the Fulbright-Nehru Program involve full or partial U.S. Government financing, visiting scholars are subject to the two-year home residence requirement associated with the J-1 visa. This means that you are not eligible to apply for status in the U.S. as permanent resident, H temporary worker/trainee, or L intra-company transferee until you have resided and been physically present in India for at least two years following your departure from the United States.


