Keynote Speakers

Dr Stefan Kusch

RWTH, Aachen, Germany

Stefan Kusch studied biology at Göttingen University (Germany) and earned his Ph.D. at RWTH Aachen University (Germany) in 2017. He then joined the INRAE in Toulouse (France), where he helped uncover the evolution of broad host range in a fungal plant pathogen. In 2019, he rejoined RWTH Aachen University to study powdery mildew fungi. His current research is funded by starting grants from the Excellent Research Space at RWTH, and the German Research Foundation. Stefan's work with powdery mildew fungi began in 2012, when he investigated effectors assuming an RNase-like fold in his Master's thesis. Since then, he has focused on the molecular genetics and evolution of plant-powdery mildew interactions. In addition to dissecting the genetics behind isolates of the cereal pathogen *Blumeria graminis* f.sp. *hordei* overcoming mlo-based broad-spectrum powdery mildew resistance, he investigates how transposable elements affect the genomes of these fungi, their regulation, and their contribution to the innovation of novel coding and noncoding RNA molecules. In a broader sense, he is leading efforts towards comparative genome analysis of powdery mildew fungi and the evolution of the obligate biotrophic lifestyle in this lineage.



Dr Jérôme Enjalbert

Senior Researcher, INRA, France

Jerome's current research aims are understanding how the management of intra-specific diversity in crops can contribute to a better performance of crops, and more specifically the effect of plant to plant interactions in wheat cultivar mixtures, through experimental approaches as well as development of models coupling ecophysiology and genetics (Wheatmix - WALTER). His work encompasses the creation of appropriate models in quantitative genetics to study the mixing ability of genotypes and contribute to the development of original breeding schemes for plant teams, both within and between different crop species; mobilising participatory approaches to co-design mixtures delivering appropriate services from farmers to end-users; and studying the impact of the management of disease resistances on the evolution of virulence of pathogen populations, focusing on wheat cultivars deployment in Europe and the selective pressure produced on rust fungal populations (RustWatch).

Dr. Firoz Hossain obtained his PhD in the year 2005 from ICAR-Indian Agricultural Research Institute, Pusa campus, New Delhi. Presently, he is working as Senior Scientist, Division of Genetics, ICAR-Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi.


Dr. Hossain has significantly contributed in the field of Plant Sciences especially in Genetics and Plant Breeding. His research work is a perfect amalgamation on use of conventional and molecular approaches in crop improvement. His research efforts led to the development of country's first provitamin A rich maize hybrid 'Pusa Vivek QPM9 Improved' using marker-assisted selection. Besides, he has also developed three quality protein maize (QPM) hybrids viz. 'Pusa HM4 Improved', 'Pusa HM8 Improved' and 'Pusa HM9 Improved' that contain high lysine and tryptophan. Dr. Hossain also developed several novel maize genetic resources rich in diverse nutritional quality traits. He has also developed agronomically promising super sweet corn genotypes.

Dr. Hossain received many prestigious awards from different societies and scientific organisations. As Principal Investigator he has handled many network projects funded by DBT, GoI and ICAR-CRP for development of nutritionally rich maize genotypes. He is an active and accomplished teacher in the Division of Genetics and has guided 3 M.Sc. and 2 Ph.D. students. He has so far published more than 60 research papers in reputed national and international journals besides other publications.

Considering all the achievements and contributions in the field of Maize Genetics and Breeding, The BOARD OF AWARDS of the Society has recommended his name for the ISGPB JOGINDER SINGH MEMORIAL AWARD 2017, as such the Society confers him the same day today on the 5th October, 2017.
