INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE BID SUBMISSION

1. The Online tender shall be submitted in accordance with these instructions and any tender not confirming to the instructions as under is liable to be rejected. These instructions shall form the part of the tender and the contract.

For Online Bid Submission, as per the directives of Department of Expenditure, this tender document has been published on the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL:<http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>). The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates.

More information useful for submitting the online bids on the CPP Portal is available obtained at www.eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app

For Registration

2. Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL:<http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) by clicking on the link “Click here to Enroll”. Enrolment on the CPP Portal is free of charge.
3. Foreign Bidders have to refer “**DSC details for foreign Bidders**” for Digital signature Certificates requirements which comes under Download Tab at <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app?page=StandardBiddingDocuments&service=page> and the remaining part is same as above and below.
4. The intending Tenderer, in case of Authorized Distributor/ Authorised Dealer shall possess valid authorized Distributorship /Dealership license from Original Equipment Manufacturers. The tenderer shall enclose the copy of the same as PDF file in Cover-I of the e-tender while submitting the tender.

 3. **Order Placements:**

 4. **Eligibility Criteria:**
 - a. The bidder should have executed similar type of orders with other Central / State /PSU /Govt. Societies for a minimum of **5 years**.
 - b. The bidders should submit the required documents / financial instruments as stipulated in para 3 of Annexure – I.
 - c. The bidder must not be blacklisted by ICAR – IARI Library, N. Delhi or any other Educational/R&D/Govt. organizations. A certificate or undertaking to this effect must be submitted.

5. **Amendment to Bidding Documents**
 - 5.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, ICAR –IARI, LIBRARY, N. DELHI-12 may, for any reason, whether on its own initiative or in response to the clarification request by a prospective bidder, modify the bid document.
 - 5.2 The amendments to the tender documents, if any, will be notified by release of Corrigendum Notice in print media / website. The amendments/ modifications will be binding on the bidders.
 - 5.3 ICAR - **IARI, LIBRARY, and NEW DELHI-110012** at its discretion may extend the deadline for the submission of bids if it thinks necessary to do so or if the bid document undergoes changes /d/uring the bidding period, in order to give prospective bidders time to take into consideration the amendments while preparing their bids.
 6. **Preparation of Bids**
Bidder should avoid, as far as possible, corrections, overwriting, erasures or postscripts in the bid documents. In case however, any corrections, overwriting, erasures or postscripts have to be made in the bids, they should be supported by dated signatures of the same authorized person signing the bid documents. However, bidder shall not be entitled to amend/ add/ delete/ correct the clauses mentioned in the entire tender document.

7. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

- 7.1. The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) must be submitted prior to the DUE DATE of submission of the online technical bid. However if the return of EMD is delayed for any reason, no interest/ penalty shall be payable to the bidder.
- 7.4. The successful bidder, on award of contract / order, must send the contract/ order acceptance in writing, within 7 days of award of contract/ order, failing which the EMD will be forfeited and the order will be cancelled.
- 7.5. **The EMD may be forfeited:**

8. Period of validity of bids

10 Late Bids

ICAR- **IARI, LIBRARY,NEW DELHI-110012** shall not be responsible and liable for the delay in receiving the bid for whatsoever reason.

11 Bid Opening & Evaluation of Bids

11.1 The technical bids will be evaluated in two steps.

- The bids will be examined based on eligibility criteria stipulated at Para 4 of **Annexure – II** to shortlist the eligible bidders.
 - The technical bids of only the short listed eligible bidders shall be evaluated based on technical specifications stipulated **at Annexure – V**.
- 11.2.1 The bidders whose technical bid is found to meet both the requirements as specified above will qualify for opening of the financial bid and will be informed about the date and time of the opening of the financial bid.

- 11.2.2 The duly constituted Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC) shall evaluate the bids. The TEC shall be empowered to take appropriate decisions on minor deviations, if any.

Procurement of Foreign& Indian Journals/E-JOURNALS

Terms and Conditions for the Subscription of Foreign and Indian Journals/E-JOURNALS:-

- i) The Bidder(s) may note that ONLINE BID will only be accepted. All the requisite supporting documents as mentioned in the bid document should and must be uploaded on-line <http://eprocure.gov.in/procure/app>. The Bids sent through FAX, E-mail, by hand and/or by post shall not be accepted /processed, in any case.
- ii) The bidders may submit duly filled and completed bidding document ONLINE as per instruction contained in the bidding documents. Incomplete bid shall be rejected. The conditions of tender shall be governed by the details contained in complete bid document as well as Procurement Manual of Library Journals and including e-journals ICAR.
- iii) Tender in any other form except on the online cpp portal/IARI website tender form shall not be entertained. The non-refundable cost of the tender Form is Rs.1000.00. In case the **tender documents are downloaded from IARI website**, the cost of the tender has to be enclosed in the form of **Demand Draft/Pay Order from Nationalized Bank drawn in favour of The Director, ICAR- IARI, New Delhi and to be attached with the Technical Bid.**

The rates should be quoted as per the BOQ uploaded on the CPP Portal. Taxes, if any, should be indicated separately. The bidders are advised to download this BOQ_XXX.xls as it is and quote their offer/rates in the permitted column and upload the same in the Financial Bid. The Bidder shall not tamper/modify downloaded price bid template in any manner, In case if the same is found to be tempered/modified in any manner, Tender will completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and tenderer is liable to be banned from doing business with ICAR-IARI, LIBRARY.

- iv) The selected firm/agency upon receipt of confirmed order shall process Institutional subscription and advance payment shall be made on behalf of ICAR-IARI to the respective publishers.
- v) Firm has to provide Subscriber Number allotted by the publisher against journals subscribed.

- vi) The journals available in dual currencies should be billed in the currency by which the converted cost is the lowest in **Indian rupees**.
- vii) **The Bid Security (EMD) will not carry any interest on it. The EMD will be refunded in full on receipt after the finalization of tender. The refund of EMD not claimed within three years from the last date of receipt of tender will stand forfeited. However, in case of tender accepted for the supply of journals, the EMD will be refunded only after depositing of the Security Deposit. The intending Firm/Vendor has to deposit Bid Security (EMD) amounting Rs.4,00,000/-(of 2% of the value of Journals or any equivalent amount fixed by ICAR Unit) in the shape of Demand Draft/Pay order/FDR from Nationalized bank drawn in favour of the Director, ICAR- IARI along with the Technical Bid.**
- viii) **The successful firm will be required to deposit the security amount at the 100% of the total order value in the shape of Bank Guarantee or fixed deposit which will be released only after completion of supply of issue(s) of Foreign and Indian journals only. No interest will be paid by ICAR- IARI on Security money. CVC guidelines vide OM No.02-07-01-CTE-30 dated Dec. 31, 2007 may be heeded for acceptance of Bank Guarantee.**
- ix) The Firm/Agency has to specify clearly the **Flat discount rate** to be given for the supply of journals keeping in view the total order value. Such discount will be subject to deduction from the bill amount itself.
- x) Journals issues so ordered are delivered by hand in the ICAR-IARI Prof. MS Swaminathan Library in good condition. The firm/agency shall procure all the journals/e-Journals subscribed for the library from the respective publishers by Air Freight arrangement at no additional cost and supply the same to the library.
- xi) The firm/Vendor has to inform about the availability of free online access to the ordered journals to the ICAR-IARI Prof. MS Swaminathan Library.
- xii) Free online facility of journals where ever it is applicable with the print order has to be IP authenticated on the Institute's I P Numbers.
- xiii) Activation of online journals has to be done by the firm without charging any additional charges or subscription.
- xiv) The firm/vendor will provide all the facilities of subscription model/license agreement with the publishers where ever applicable.
- xv) The subscription agency has to send periodical reminders automatically to the publishers concerned for any non-receipt of issues and send copies of reminders to us for our verification and records. Agency/firm should provide web based claim management support so that the order/delivery/claim status can be checked by ICAR-IARI Prof. MS Swaminathan Library as and when required. The company should submit documentary evidence (In the form of website print outs) of such facility and also give website address where this service can be checked.

- xvi) **The firm should have last Five years' experience in supply of foreign and Indian journals** to ICAR Institute's/SAU, Central universities/other UGC recognized universities. The firm /agency should make an undertaking that it will be in a position to supply the foreign and Indian journals as per the list attached.
- xvii) **The firm has to pay 2% penalty (up to 10% maximum) against late supply of print/online journals/ periodical.** The firm/vendor will refund the proportionate cost/value/amount along with 10% penalty for the not supplied journals/issues in lieu thereof in the form of refund by means of a Demand Draft favouring Director ICAR-IARI. The firm will refund to Library full amount of subscription of journals along with the penalty which are not supplied within six months from receipt of payment.

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(No penalty will be charged, if the suppliers provide valid and satisfactory reasons for non-supply of the journals with documentary evidence received from the publishers. The documents relating to non-supply of journals should be submitted well in advance to avoid penalty).

xvii) No interest would be payable on amount paid by the subscription agent to the publisher on account of delay in payment by the institute.

xviii) The Firm/agency should give undertaking that the firm have necessary permission to deal with foreign and Indian periodicals subscription and make necessary payment in foreign and Indian currency. Further it should fulfil all statutory requirements.

xix) **The successful firm will have to enter into an agreement with the Director, ICAR-IARI Prof. MS Swaminathan Library on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.100/-** (Rupees One hundred only), the cost of which has to be borne by the Tenderer himself.

xx) The Institute reserves the right to discontinue the service of the firm on the basis of performance in terms of supply of journals subscribed through them.

xxi) The Director, ICAR- IARI reserves the right to accept or to reject any or all items(s) if the tender at any stage without assigning any reason. The decision of the Director, ICAR-IARI in this regard will be final and binding.

xxiii) **All journals are to be supplied for the calendar year January to December**, supply of the periodicals should commence from the issue no. 1 of the volume starting during the year unless specified otherwise.

xxiv) The rates of the journals /titles must be submitted only by charging on **current bank exchange rate** (TT selling rate).

xxv) Initially the contract for supply of journals/e-journals will be **one calendar year i.e. (January to December)** of a year and can be extended for further **one year** with the approval of Director, ICAR –IARI New Delhi-110012

xxvi) **Force majeure:** Any failure of omission or commission to carry out the provisions of the contract by the supplier shall not give rise to any claim by either of the party to contract, if such failure of omission or commission arises from an act of God, which shall include all acts of natural calamities such as fire, flood, earthquake, hurricane or any pestilence or from civil

strikes, compliance with any statute and /or regulation of the government, lockouts and strikes, riots, embargo or from any political or other reasons beyond the supplier's own control including war (whether declared or not) civil war or state or insurrection, provided that notice or the occurrence of any event by either party to the other shall be given within two weeks from the date of occurrence of such an event which could be attributed to Force majeure conditions.
